

Allowable and Unallowable Costs

• Allowable Costs:

- o Curriculum
- o Career Interest/Aptitude Testing for 8th Graders
- o Consultant Fees (reimbursement for travel, materials, etc.)
- o Advertisements through media, pamphlets, brochures, posters, etc.
- o Equipment not exceeding \$500.00 per item
- o Conferences and Professional Development for Career and Technical
- o When traveling, the following Paris Junior College per diems will be allowed:
 - * Mileage - \$.40 per mile
 - * Hotel - \$85.00 per night (will not reimburse for state taxes)
 - * Meals - \$26.00 per day or if not gone all day (will not reimburse tips):
 - \$6.00 for Breakfast
 - \$8.00 for Lunch
 - \$12.00 for Dinner

• Unallowable Costs:

- o Administrative Costs
- o Amusement, social activities and incidental entertainment costs (i.e. alcoholic beverages, gratuities, door prizes, gifts, etc.)
- o Memorabilia, gifts, souvenirs (i.e. T-shirts, caps, coffee mugs, flashlights, key chains, pencils, pens, rulers, tote bags, etc.)
- o Purchase of food for meetings, career fairs, career days, etc.
- o Direct student expenses (i.e. textbooks, fees, scholarships, transportation, childcare, etc.)
- o Purchase of computers
- o Equipment exceeding \$500.00 per item
- o Testing fees that are not Career Interest/Aptitude (i.e. PSAT, SAT, ASVAB, Myers-Briggs Indicator, etc.), or evaluation of testing results
